ADVERTISEMENT FOR POSITION OF -SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS-

The *Livingston Parish School Board* (LPSB) is seeking an exceptional leader to serve as its Superintendent of Schools. Located just to the east of Baton Rouge and approximately an hour north of New Orleans, the LPSB serves and educates a diverse population of over 26,000 students at 51 school sites with approximately 4000 employees. The LPSB's annual operating budget is approximately \$390,000,000.00.

Qualifications and Standards: Each applicant must meet or exceed as of the date of application the qualifications for superintendent listed in Bulletin 746 Louisiana Standards for State Certification of School Personnel. Accordingly, the applicant must possess a valid Louisiana teaching certificate which documents School Superintendent as an area of certification or possess a letter from the Louisiana Department of Education certifying their immediate eligibility to serve as a school superintendent in Louisiana. **Proof of such certification must be included within the application packet.**

Applications: Applications for the position of Superintendent of Schools will be received in the form of a cover letter that encloses a resume and/or CV, along with the qualification credentials noted above. **Deadline for Applications:** All applications must be hand delivered or **post-marked on or before March 30, 2024.** Applications hand delivered or post-marked after that date will not be considered.
